INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count One

Threats Against the President of the United States, and Aiding and Abetting
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 871 and 2)

On or about January 1, 2007, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, the defendants, **Joseph Arthur Bolton** and **James Wade Brantley**, aided and abetted by each other, knowingly and willfully made threats to take the life of, and inflict bodily harm upon, President George W. Bush, specifically by making oral statements to the effect that one of them, or both of them working together, would shoot the President with a rifle at the President's ranch near Crawford, Texas.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 871 and 2.

Count Two
Threats Against the President of the United States
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871)

On or about January 18, 2007, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, the defendant, **James Wade Brantley** knowingly and willfully made threats to take the life of, and inflict bodily harm upon, President George W. Bush, specifically by making oral statements to the effect that he would shoot the President with a rifle in or near Crawford, Texas, and by making statements about specific locations from which he could fire the rifle.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871.

Count Three
Threats Against the President of the United States
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871)

On or about January 24, 2007, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, the defendant, **James Wade Brantley** knowingly and willfully made threats to take the life of, and inflict bodily harm upon, President George W. Bush, specifically by making oral statements to the effect that he would shoot the President with a modified military .30-06 caliber rifle at the President's ranch near Crawford, Texas.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871.

Count Four
Threats Against the President of the United States
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 871)

On or about January 25, 2007, in the Fort Worth Division of the Northern District of Texas, the defendant, **James Wade Brantley** knowingly and willfully made threats to take the life of, and inflict bodily harm upon, President George W. Bush, specifically by making oral statements about a person who would assist him with shooting the President, and about the equipment that he would use in shooting the President.



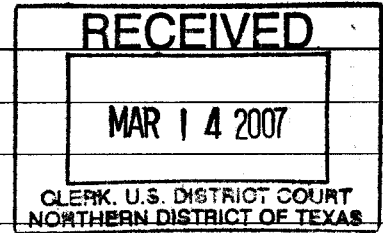

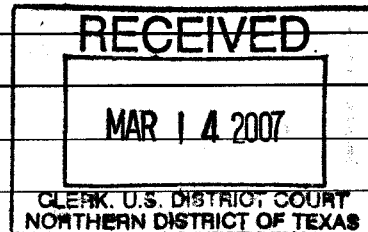
